Water quality is affected by chemical run-off that makes it to the sea. The ocean, while it seems so vast, had long been a dumping ground for much of the waste produced on land. From solids to chemicals and even nuclear products, waste has been dumped in the ocean with the mindset that it will eventually disperse and become harmless. It is not harmless though, and can become even more concentrated and dangerous after entering the food chain. Even when humans aren't directly dumping waste into the oceans though, toxic chemicals are still making their way to the sea.

Fertilizers, pesticides and other products often make it to waterways through chemical run-off. These chemicals can seep into the soil and travel for long distances, eventually reaching the oceans where they can be carried by currents. Learn more about Rosalita and St Thomas' Cause.

Plastic Debris



Plastic Rae

It is estimated that more than 100 million marine animals are killed each year due to plastic debris in the ocean. More than 80% of this plastic comes from land. It washes out from our beaches and streets. It travels through storm drains into streams and rivers. It flies away from landfills into our seas. As a result, thousands of sea turtles accidentally swallow these plastics, mistaking them for food. Most of the debris is recognizable: plastic bags, balloons, bottles, degraded buoys, plastic packaging, and food wrappers. Some plastics aren't so easy

to see, so small, in fact, that it is invisible to the naked eye. If sea turtles ingest these particles, they can become sick or even starve. Learn more about Jujube, Sheldon, and Ursula's Cause.

The Eviction Diversion Protectors rescues those who have been forced to the breaking point of homelessness by unexpected hardships and limited resources. Many have been laid off but have recently found employment. Others have suffered medical emergencies, and are slowly recovering. Unfortunately, long time periods of unemployment and medical bills leave families far behind in rent to catch up on their own. These families are not looking for a hand out but a hand up.



Evictions

Eviction comes with a heavy price tag because it leaves a detrimental judgment on an individual credit for 7 years. This detrimental judgment ruins the chances of redemption in finding suitable safe housing for families. Evictions has caused homelessness in Collin County and it impacts children's learning ability in the classrooms. As of last year, Collin County ISD reported close to 2,000 homeless students.

Affordable housing

Families looking to establish a solid base for success benefit from access to home ownership. Low-income families or those from minority groups with historically less access to home ownership face multiple obstacles in following a traditional path to home ownership through mortgage lending:

- . Nonexistent or troubled credit history due to past unreliable income or lack of strategies for establishing solid credit
- · Inexperience establishing a base of savings
- Incomplete understanding of how to determine what the family can afford
- Unfamiliarity with budgeting necessary to meet ongoing obligations
- Difficulty of obtaining habitable structures and/or land in an area they can afford

Amyion Foundation boosts families on their road to success by easing many of these burdens. Through our nonprofit status and partnership with other agencies, Amyion Foundation purchases structures in need of renovation as well as land. Working with our families on financial literacy, we aid them with a path to home ownership by teaching them to check and repair their credit, determine what type of home they can afford, and assisting them in budgeting. 
