Multiple school changes cause behavioral and educational disruptions. Only 50% of youth in foster care graduate high school, less than 10% graduate from college. Nearly 1 in 5 youth will become homeless after age 18 and teen girls in foster care are twice as likely to become pregnant by age 18.

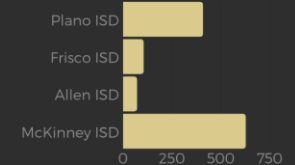


## Evictions

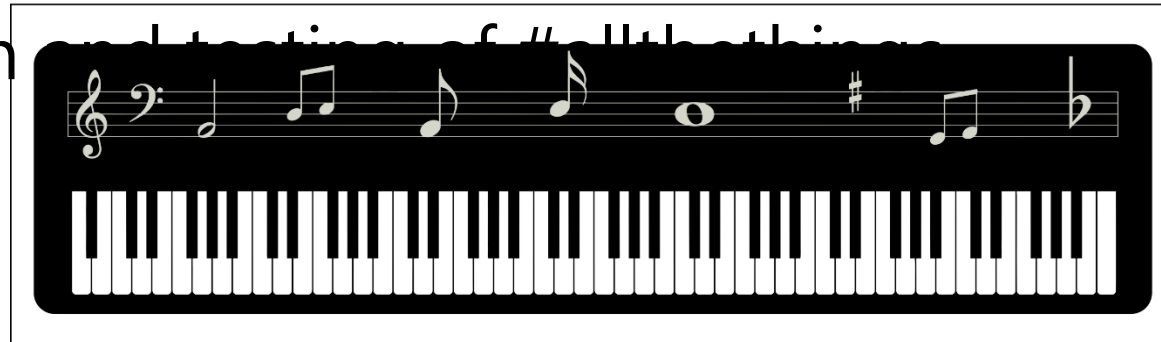

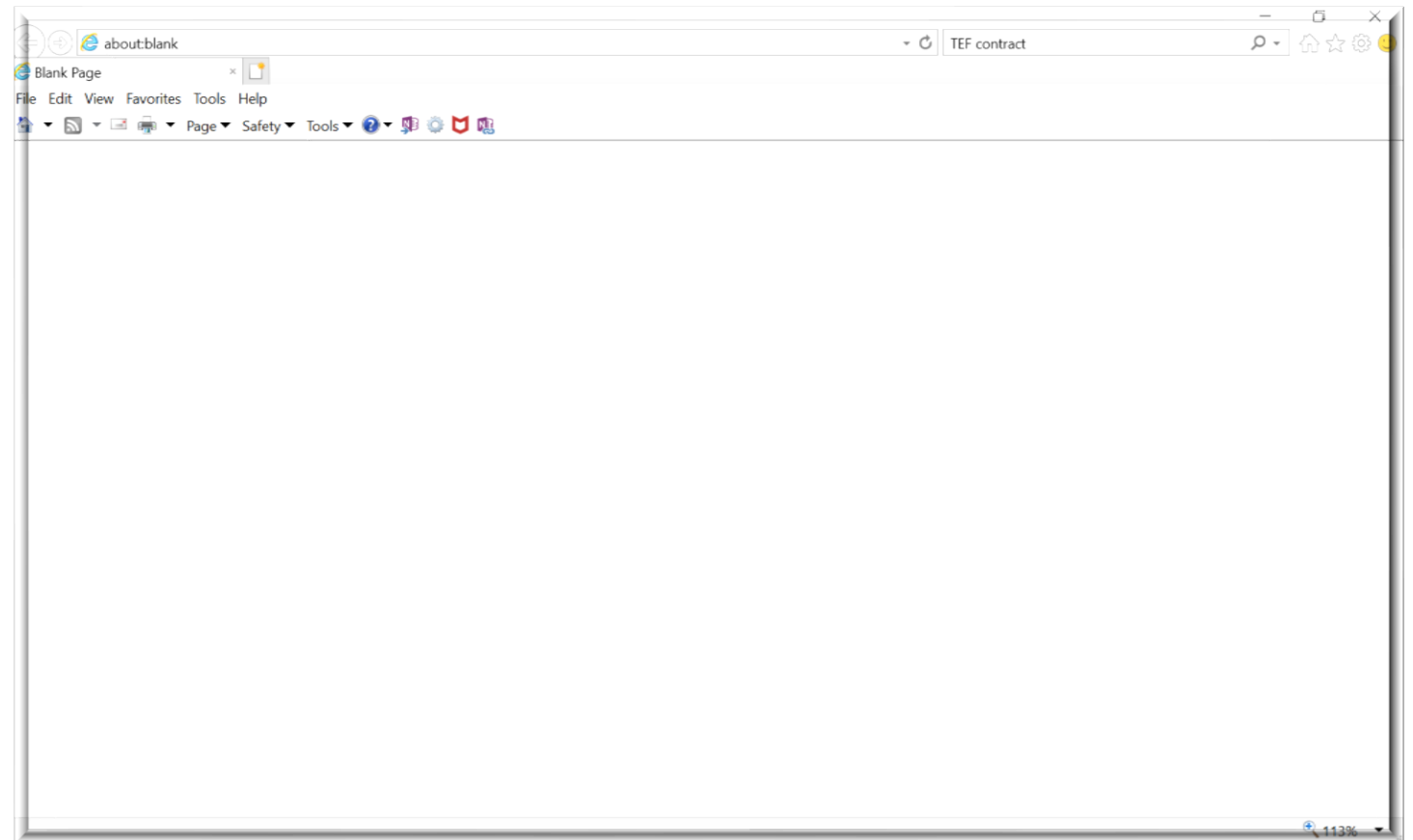

- Nonexistent or troubled credit history due to past unreliable income or lack of strategies for establishing solid credit
- Inexperience establishing a base of savings
- Incomplete understanding of how to determine what the family can afford
- Unfamiliarity with budgeting necessary to meet ongoing obligations
- Difficulty of obtaining habitable structures and/or land in an area they can afford
